We can say **Alhamdulillah** for Allah SWT providing us with delicious food to eat.

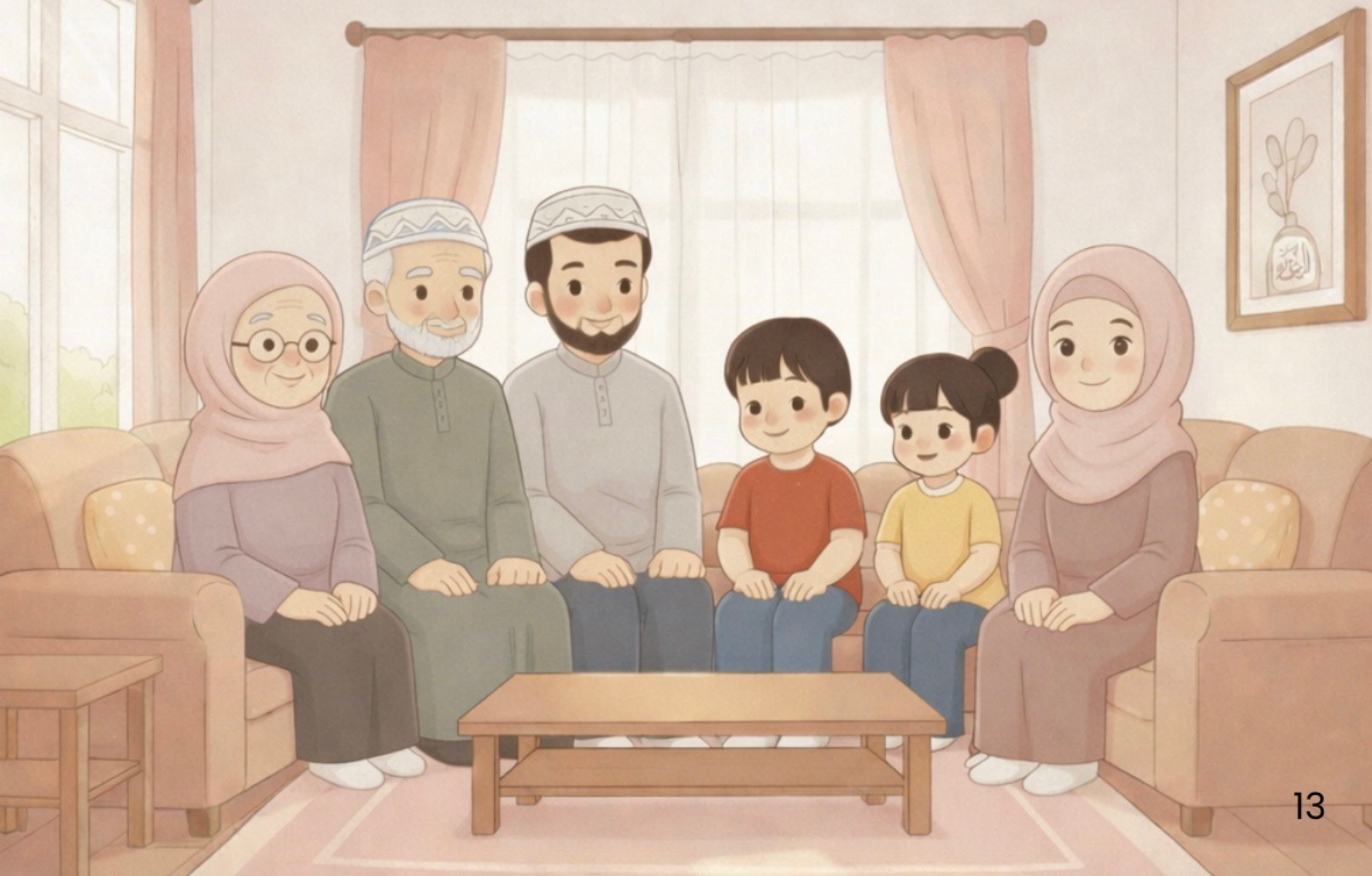


We can say **Alhamdulillah** for Allah SWT providing us with a beautiful home and many clothes to wear.

الله أكبر

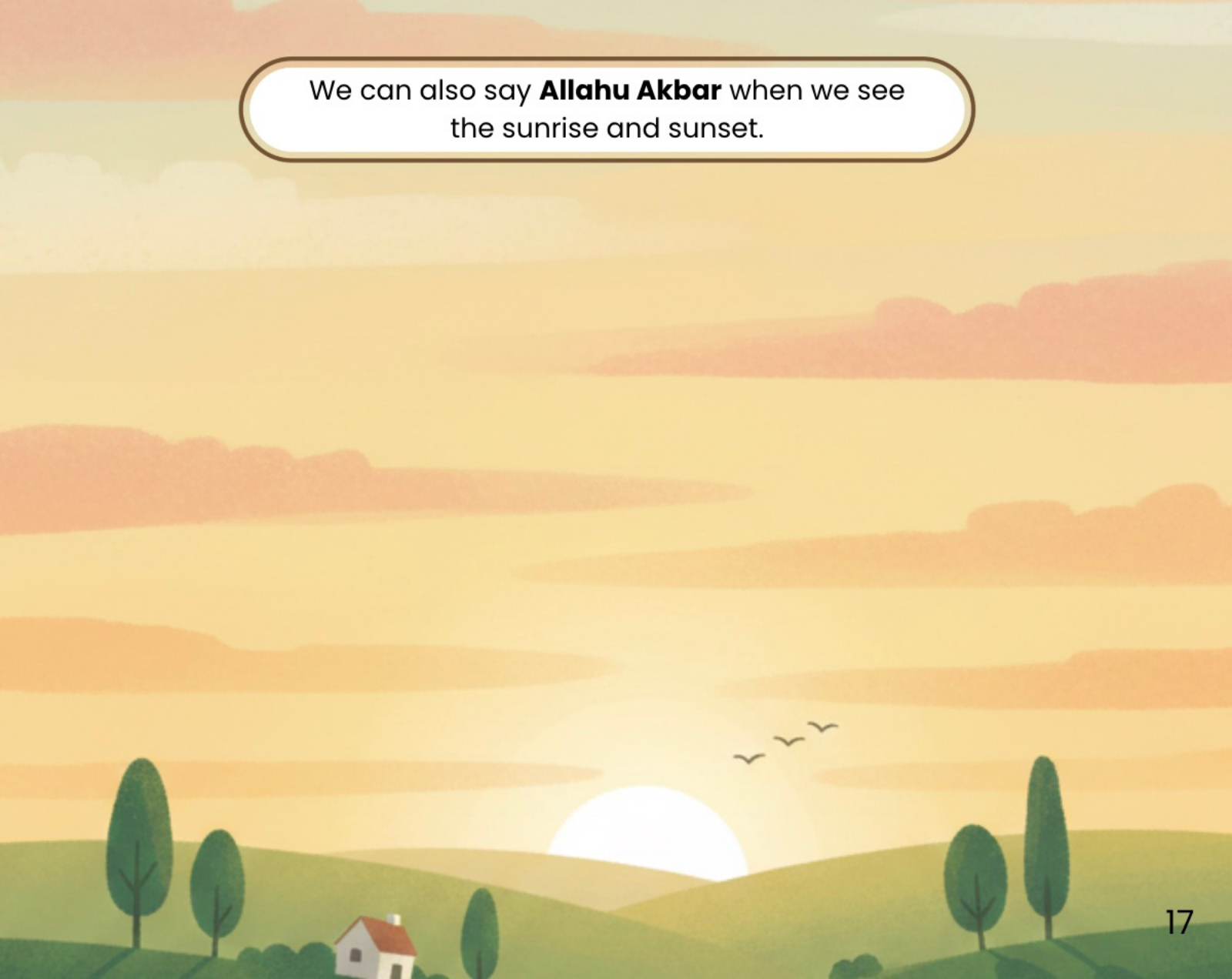
We say **Allahu Akbar** when it's time for prayer.

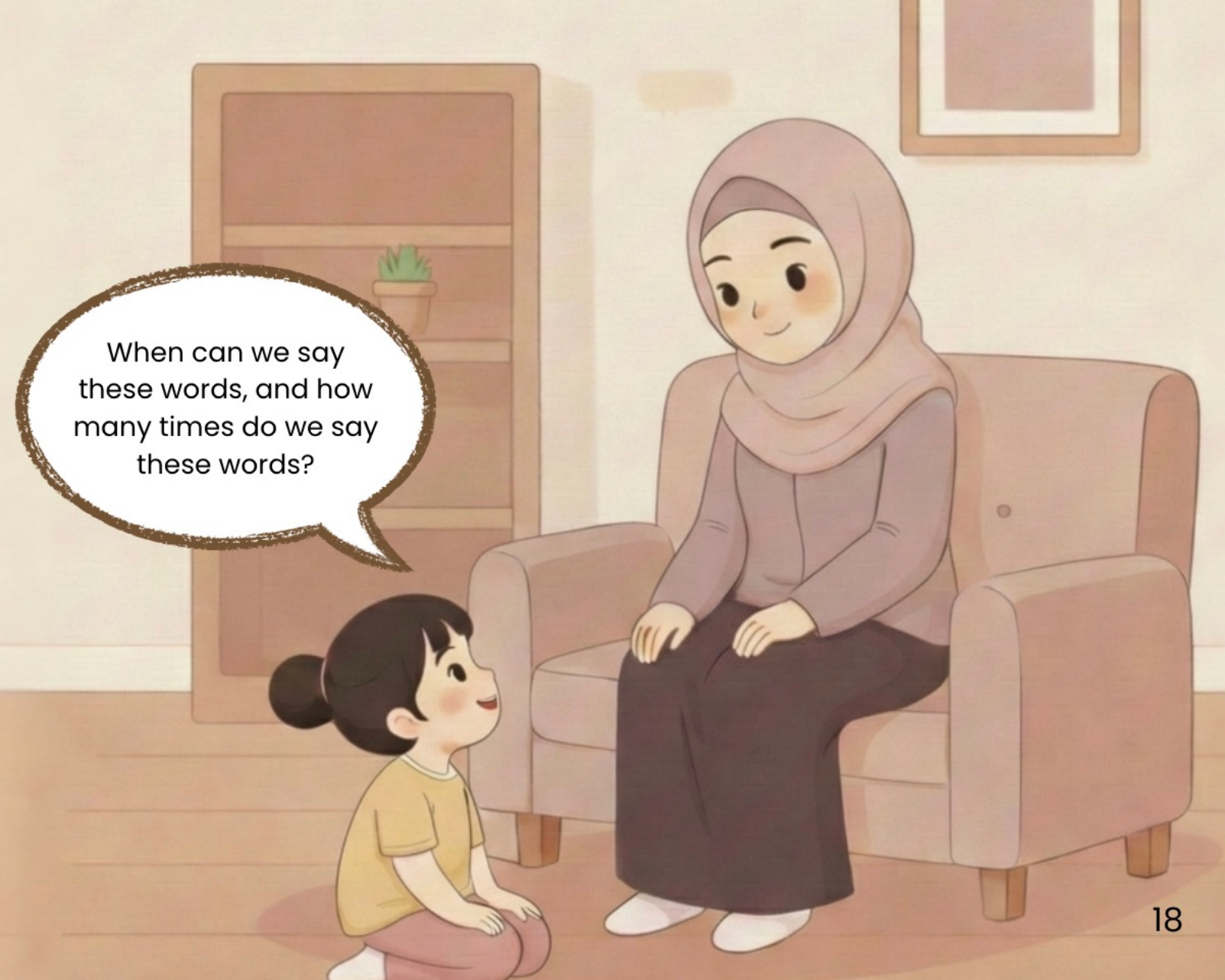


We can say **Allahu Akbar** when we see a newborn baby.
